The data collected from users is stored on servers located in the U.S. to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the appropriate use of personal information. Wunderman has adopted appropriate procedures to safeguard and secure personal information and follows generally accepted industry standards to protect the personal information collected by and/or submitted both during transmission and upon receipt.

Your information is protected by computer security mechanisms that may include firewalls, encryption, monitoring software, data and network segmentation, and passwords. The transmission of information is protected with the use of secure socket layer technology (SSL). No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure.
